

SLOVAK-RELATED READING LIST:

Many of the following publications comprised a list I compiled during May, 2003 for high school and college teachers who were to participate in the Fulbright-Hays Seminar Abroad Program: "The Heart of Europe: Czech and Slovak Republics" at the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill (May 29-30). That was a pre-orientation for their trip to those two countries. Since then, there have been further publications of interest for persons wanting to become familiar with Slovak-related topics. The First Catholic Slovak Union asked me to provide the updated list for its members. I continue to update the list (January, 2016).
